

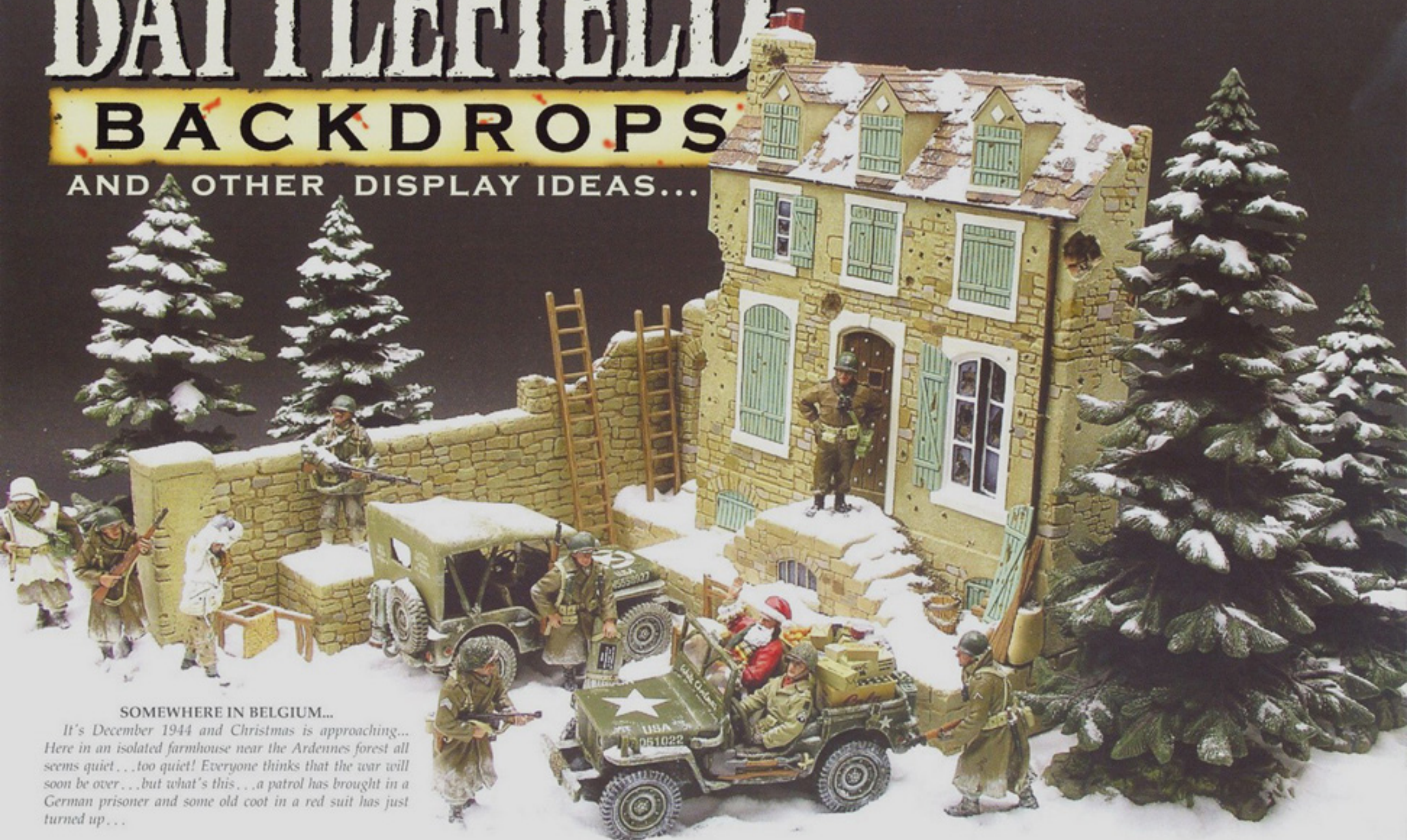

HELPFUL HINTS:

This landscaped base was made up of hand-carved polystyrene sheets sculpted to form a roadway. Materials used include white glue (Elmer's Glue) and small stones from the garden.

Model railway and hobby stores are great places to find scale trees, bushes and 'flock' grass. The longer grass is plastic and came from an ornamental fish store.

HELPFUL HINTS:

By combining the SS Headquarters building (LAH42) and two flanking SS building annexes (LAH43) collectors can have a frontage of 24 inches that can easily fit on most display shelves.

SIX WEEKS IN MAY & JUNE

It took the German Army just over 40 days to conquer most of Western Europe in May and June 1940.

In this scene a Wehrmacht armoured column moves through the ruins of a French town.
